### PUBLIC COMMENT

Mayor Grim asked if anyone in the public had any comments.

Mr. Michael Diaz of Pan Tops Drive in Stephens City VA addressed Council about an update in the paving of Pan Tops Drive. Mayor Grim commented that it is not a street owned by the Town of Stephens City and it would be the responsibility of the owner to ensure that the street be up to VDOT standards so that it could be paved.

Mr. Bob Bowden with South Frederick LLC addressed Council. Mr. Bowden expressed his concern in regards to rumor that the Town would not be giving water connections to the fifty five homes that they will be building on the North End of Town. Town Manager Mike Majher commented that the Town had not denied a request for connections and that the Town fully anticipates issuing connections when the property is developed.

Ms. Roslyn Jones a Pastor from the church on Mulberry Street addressed Council. Ms. Jones commented that her church would like to open a Day Learning Center and is requesting a special permit to do so. Mayor Grim advised Ms. Jones to appear before the Planning Commission at the March meeting to get a recommendation.

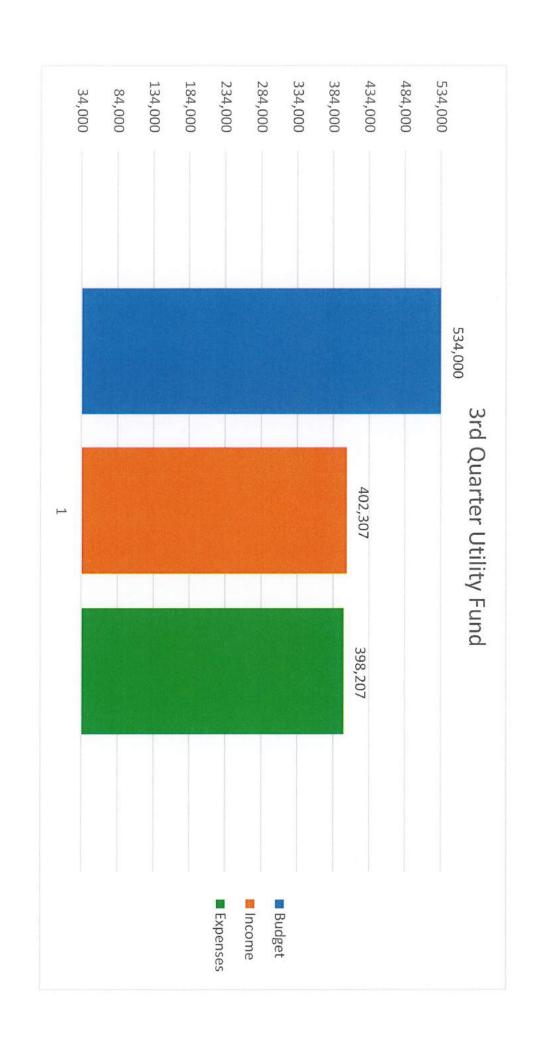
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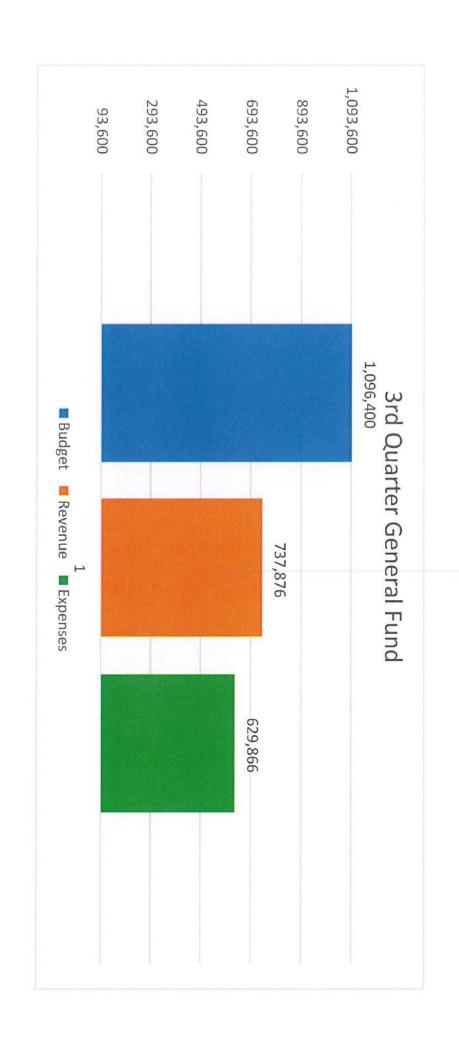
