#### DROUGHT WARNING

On Wednesday, August 30, 2023, the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) issued a Drought Warning for the Shenandoah Region. Because of our commitment to protecting our customers and the vital resources on which they rely, Stephens City is implementing Drought Warning procedures effective immediately.

Residential customers are encouraged to reduce water usage by 15%, while non-residential customers are encouraged to reduce usage by 20%. These water savings can be achieved through voluntary conservation measures and a mandatory reduction in nonessential water use.



#### FREDERICK COUNTY OPEN AIR BURN BAN IN EFFECT

Due to the increased risk for wildfires due to the current extreme atmospheric and drought conditions, Frederick County will be under an open air burn ban effective Tuesday, September 5th until further notice.

No person shall kindle or maintain or authorize to be kindled or maintained any open burning during this time. This prohibition includes all bonfires, ceremonial fires, camping fires, barrel fires, etc. This regulation does not include barbecue grills, smokers, or any device that emits smoke through a chimney or stack.
