FROM THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR

There continues to be some major confusion as to the proper procedure for the placement of trash for pick up and the removal of trash containers afterwards. Trash should not be placed on the curbside prior to 4:00 pm on Tuesday for Wednesday pick up. Trash containers are to be removed as soon as possible, at least before the next day. They are not to be left on the curb for days. All trash must be placed in proper containers with secure lids. Plastic bags are <u>not</u> proper containers. We are asking everyone to please adhere to these regulations. These are necessary for the health, welfare and beautification of our Town.

Landlords, please relay this to your tenants.

Rental and purchase of trash and recycling (65 or 95 gallon) containers is available at the town office. This can be arranged in person at our Locust Street office or over the telephone. This program is provided by the town at cost through our waste and recycling contractor, American Disposal. The annual cost of renting both a trash and recycling can is \$25.

Water and Sewer Billing

Water and sewer bills are due on **Monday**, **December 4, 2017 by 5:00 pm.** After 5:00 pm, a 10% penalty will be applied to late accounts. On

Tuesday, December 12, service will be discontinued for delinquency. An administrative fee of \$50 plus the full amount of the bill must be paid before service can be restored.

A drop box is available at the Town Office for check or money order payments. **Do not put cash in the drop box.** Online payments can be made at the Town's website with Discover, Visa or MasterCard.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT PAYMENTS OVER THE PHONE.

February April

June

August

October

Dropping Temperatures Can Mean Frozen Pipes

Most of the time the first place to check for a frozen water line is an exposed drafty area beneath or within your home or business. Find and be aware of where the cutoff valve is within your home.

Do not open a water meter box unless you have contacted the Town. Town water meters are insulated and not likely to freeze. If you know that the pipes at your property are prone to freezing letting a faucet drip may help to prevent this on especially cold days.
