Notice of Utility Rate Increase

You will likely have noticed that your utility bill this month is higher than usual. This is the result of a water and sewer rate increase. The Town Council advertised and held a public hearing for community input on this matter. The rates were adopted by council and became effective July 3rd.

This is the first increase to rates in seven years. The town has delayed this increase as long as possible but it is clear rates must be increased to help restore the Capital Improvement Fund. It is imperative that funds be available for emergency repairs of water and sewer lines to keep our system operational and its users protected.

Stephens City is committed to running a safe and effective water and sewer system for our citizens and this increase will help allow us to do that.

Sec. 22-101. Schedule for in-Town water and sewer rates.

The rate of charge for water and sewer service, or for water service alone but where sewer is available, supplied within the corporate limits of the Town shall be metered and based upon the metered flow. Charges are bi-monthly as follows:

First 3,000 gallons or less: Water - \$19.97

Sewer - \$46.61

All additional usage: Water - \$4.34 per 1000 gal. or fraction thereof

Sewer - \$10.02 per 1000 gal. or fraction thereof

Water and sewer bills are due on Monday, October 1, 2018 by 5:00 pm. After 5:00 pm, a 10% penalty will be applied to late accounts. On Tuesday, October 9, 2018 service will be discontinued for delinquency. An administrative fee of \$50 plus the full amount of the bill must be paid before service can be restored.
