Now that Spring is upon us and we look forward to getting outside and doing our yard cleanup, just a reminder that yard waste is not permitted in normal trash pick up. The Yard Waste site is available to all residents and a key can be signed out at the Town Office. Again I feel the need to remind everyone that there continue to be violations regarding proper trash placement.

Trash is not permitted to be placed on the curbside prior to 4pm on the Tuesday before Wednesday trash pickup. Trash must be placed in sealed containers with a lid.

Trash cans are to be removed from curbs no later than 7pm on trash collection day. Trash cans left out are subject to pick and disposal by Town Staff.

These regulations are necessary to control liter throughout the Town as well as sanitary concerns.

Water and Sewer Billing

Water and sewer bills are due on Monday, April 3, 2017
by 5:00 pm. After 5:00 pm, a 10% penalty will be applied to late accounts. On Tuesday, April 11 service will be discontinued for delinquency. An administrative fee of \$25 plus the full amount of the bill must be paid before service can be restored. A drop box is available at the Town Office for check or money order payments. Do not put cash in the drop box. Online payments can be made at the Town's website with Discover, Visa or MasterCard.

Please allow 2 business days for online payments to post to your account.

FROM THE TOWN MANAGER'S DESK

With the unpredictable temperature changes we have experienced lately and we move into Spring, water leaks become a greater possibility. As the temperature fluctuates pipes expand, contract and move. This makes it more likely for residents to encounter a burst or leaking water line. It is important that you occasionally inspect your pipes and fixtures for possible leaks. Even the smallest crack, loose fitting or unsealed toilet valve can amount to a large increase in your water bill. Below is a graphic which illustrates the potential for significant water loss.

| Size of Leak | Waste per Month @ 60 psi |
|--------------|--------------------------|
| 1/4 inch | 400,000 gallons |
| 1/8 inch | 100,000 gallons |
| 1/16 inch • | 25,000 gallons |
| 1/32 inch • | 6,000 gallons |
