

### Water and Sewer Billing

Water and sewer bills are due on Monday, April 6, 2020
by 5:00 pm. After 5:00 pm, a 10% penalty will be applied to late accounts. On Tuesday, April 14, 2020 service will be discontinued for delinquency. An administrative fee of \$50 plus the full amount of the bill must be paid before service can be restored. A drop box is available at the Town Office for check or money order payments. Do not put cash in the drop box. Online payments can be made at the Town's website with Discover, Visa or MasterCard.

Please allow 2 business days for online payments to post to your account.
