Water and Sewer Billing

Water and sewer bills are due on Monday, October 7, 2019 by 5:00 pm. After 5:00 pm, a 10% penalty will be applied to late accounts. On Tuesday, October 15, 2019 service will be discontinued for delinquency. An administrative fee of \$50 plus the full amount of the bill must be paid before service can be restored.
