Throughout the month of November, the Town will provide leaf collection every Monday. Place your bags of leaves at the curb by 8:00 am. Please do not include plastic flower pots with dead plants in with your leaves. January 2 & 9 will be tree collection days.

Water and Sewer Billing

Water and sewer bills are due on Monday, December 5, 2022 by 5:00 pm. After 5:00 pm, a 10% penalty will be applied to late accounts. On Tuesday, December 13, 2022 service will be discontinued for delinquency. An administrative fee of \$50 plus the full amount of the bill must be paid before service can be restored.

A drop box is available at the Town Office for check or money order payments. Do not put cash in the drop box. Online payments can be made at the Town's website with Discover, Visa or MasterCard. Please allow 2 business days for online payments to post to your account.
